#### INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE

Degree Audits are used at UCR as a means for students and staff to track completion of curriculum requirements towards graduation. This procedure explains the use and purpose of the Degree Works GPA calculator.

#### FORMS

The degree audit is located within Degree Works. There are no forms in Degree Works.

#### PROCEDURES

#### TERM CALCULATOR

#### STEPS

- 1. From the GPA Calc tab click Term Calculator.
  - a. This calculator can be used to predict the cumulative GPA by entering anticipated grades for courses in which the student is currently enrolled
- 2. The system will auto populate the **Current GPA** field which uses the cumulative GPA from Banner and shown on the *Student View* worksheet. The *Units Earned So Far* field will also be auto populated.
  - a. Please note that the value populated in the *Units Earned So Far* field and the *Units Applied* in the degree block field may differ due to UCR's policies regarding the cumulative GPA calculation. All unit bearing courses that do not calculate into the cumulative GPA will be excluded from *Units Earned So Far* such as repeated courses, Pass/Fail (S/NC), and transfer work from non-UC institutions. In the example shown below, the *Units Earned So Far*

preloaded with a value of 66 which accurately reflects UCR's GPA policies. This value should not be adjusted even though the *Units Applied* in the degree block is 123. The *Units Applied* value will also depend on whether or not *inprogress* or *preregistered* classes are included when processing a degree audit since they do calculate into the total.
